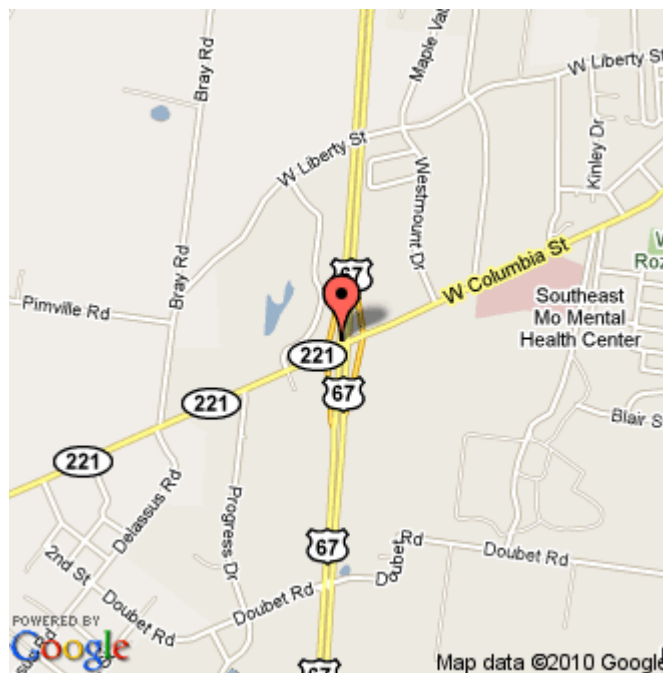
Basic Room: Ground Floor can be smoking or non-smoking. Patio or non-patio. \$62.95

### **From St. Louis**

Take I-55 south out of St. Louis to U.S. Hwy. 67, just south of the Festus (Route A) exit. Turn right (Exit 174) onto southbound U.S. Hwy. 67 and drive past Bonne Terre, Park Hills, Leadington and into Farmington. On the south side of Farmington is the Route W / 221 overpass. Exit onto State Road W / 221, turn left and cross over Hwy 67. Prior to the first stop light on the left is the Tradition Inn and Spokes Restaurant.



### POINTS OF LOCAL INTEREST

1. Missouri Mines State Historic Site (Park Hills, MO) 10 minutes. Mining and Geology Museum
2. St. Joe State Park (Park Hills, MO) 10 minutes. Fishing, Picnicking, Camping, 11 mile Bicycle Trail, ATV riding
3. Hawn State Park (Weingarten area) 15 minutes. Hiking, Picnicking, Camping
4. Ste. Genevieve, MO (1780's French settlement with many sites open) 25 minutes
5. Crown Winery & Brewery (Free van pickup at Tradition Inn on weekends)
6. Six other wineries
7. Two large antique stores (5 minutes)
8. Fort Davidson & Battle of Pilot Knob , 20 minutes. Picnicking, Fort Ruins, Museum
9. Elephant Rocks State Park, 23 minutes. Hiking, Picnicking
10. General James McCormick House (not open to public, but can give directions)
