Little is known about Craig. His records with the camp were missing since before 2000 so it is possible he was a member of the Sherman Camp who transferred in. He served a long time as camp council with US Grant Camp 68.

He apparently served in Korea as he was trying to find other members of the 1993rd AACCS (Air Force Communication Squadron) at OL-14 (Kimpoo Korea) and was interested in the service dates from June 1952 to May 1953.



There are records of him having a ham radio license in the 1950s at his Shrewsbury, MO, address. His call letters were K0IZC.

In the 1970s he was a treasurer of National Model Railroad Association.

He passed away on 5 Aug 2007, but unfortunately no records indicate where he is buried.
