
Robert Joseph Amsler, Sr.



Robert Joseph Amsler was born on May 15 1932, in St. Louis, MO, to Theodore Amsler (10 Apr 1891 -) and Thalitha Ann Amsler (born Moeller 17 Mar 1902 -).

Robert had 4 siblings: Theodore Frank Amsler, Charles Kenneth Amsler and 2 other siblings. His wife was Rosemay Helen Dalton, who passed away in 2015. His children are of Robert Joseph Jr. (Suzanne) Amsler and Michelle M. Groppe.

Robert Amsler served in Korea as a Corporal in C-B TRY 189th FA BN AP086. He enlisted on 28 Oct 1952 and was honorably discharged on 30 Sep 1954. He

was a recipient of the SUVCW War Medal for that conflict. Robert Sr. is buried at Jefferson Barracks Section 1V Site 1849.

He was a charter member of the US Grant Camp 68, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War. His ancestor was Casimer Amsler, Private, Co. D, 2nd MO - US Reserve Corps who mustered in on May 7, 1861. His unit was present at the Camp Jackson Affair and later until discharged on guard duty at Bird's Point (across from Cairo, IL – protecting river access at the junction of the Ohio and Mississippi Rivers. Casimer was honorably discharged 16 Aug 1861.

Robert passed away on December 24 2004, at age 72 in St. Louis, MO.
